The board received a statement from the Bank of New York/Melon, Commissioner Corino will file it.

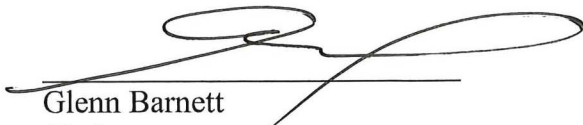
Commissioner Corino reported that he prepared Federal tax form 941 and NYS form 45 for the first quarter and sent them in with payments.

Commissioner Barnett reported that Orchid Contracting has completed the road restoration from the prior water services leak on Westminster Road.

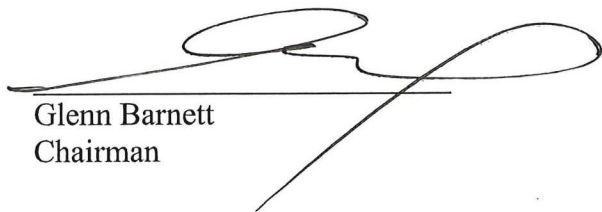

Commissioner Barnett reported that he hand delivered the retainer Check to Jeremy Walsh, ESQ to authorize him to proceed with representing the district.

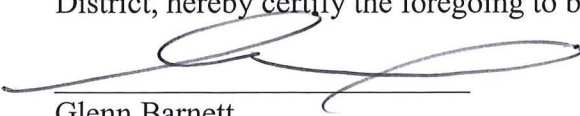

They found the hydrants located on Archer Place and on Avon Place are not in good shape, both are operating but may require some maintenance work. Commissioner Barnett has contacted Orchid to examine and check the hydrants to determine if work is required on them.

A report was received of water in the street, in front of 80 Buckingham Road, Commissioner Barnett contacted Orchid Contracting to perform an emergency investigation, they found an old, abandoned water service to be leaking. Orchid properly removed and capped the service tap at the main to repair the leak.

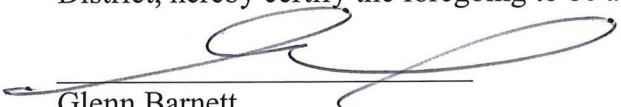
Commissioner Corino reported that he received an invoice from ESRI, the provider of the district G.I.S. software and that he will be processing payment to them.
