
Commissioner Rockensies reported that he performed a mark-out at 20 Hempstead Turnpike, at the location he marked the water service and curb-box

A representative from PSEG was on-site and noted the work required as a result of their conduits being installed, preventing the west side of Westminster Road from accessing the existing water main on the east side.

The Board received a notice of policy conditional renewal from its insurance company, the renewal is coming up at the beginning of 2026, no action is required at this time.




The required poll inspector affidavits and certifications were completed and will be hand-delivered to the Town of Hempstead Clerk office.
